THE PREAKNESS STAKES

Get ready for a day to remember! May 18th is when the legendary Preakness Stakes shows its value. It is more than a race; it is a tradition, a celebration, and a piece of history. On June 8, 2024, the venerable Belmont
Stakes will celebrate its 156th running, not at

Racecourse. This temporary relocation is due
to ongoing construction at Belmont Park, but
the spirit of the "Test of the Champion"
remains undiminished. As the third and final
leg of the Triple Crown, following the
Kentucky Derby and the Preakness Stakes,
the Belmont Stakes holds a special place in
the hearts of racing enthusiasts.

The Belmont Stakes, also known as the "Run for the Carnations," is the oldest of the Triple Crown races, predating the Kentucky Derby by eight years and the Preakness Stakes by six. Since its first run in 1867, inspired by the Epsom Derby and the Grand Prix de Paris, the race has been a showcase of endurance, with its current distance of 1.5 miles (2.4 kilometers) making it the longest and most demanding.

The Derby Trophy, an exquisite silver dish adorned with a golden rim and inscribed with the names of past victors, was first presented in 1909. While the original trophy is at the National Horseracing Museum for safekeeping, each winner is honored with a replica to celebrate their achievement.
